The applicant can choose subjects just from the same semester, organizing a private student programme is not available. For checking the prerequisite, we need the transcript of records of the previous study in English

Rules and regulations

Academic Policies

Class attendance and participation in scheduled laboratories and practices is required. No more than 3 times of absence is allowed from each subject during a semester.

Students are expected to take examinations when scheduled.

A course is considered dropped if:

- -The student misses class more than 3 times
- -The student has failed exam.
- -The student is found ineligible to take the examination on repeated attempts.

An ESN TUTOR programme is offered for all international ERASMUS students for having a better start with all practical issues like opening a bank account, registration procedures, etc.

- 2. <u>Semmelweis University</u> After having received the paper application, the signed learning agreement will be sent within 6 weeks.
- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 2 weeks after the
 assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to
 the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the interinstitutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

- 5. <u>Victor Babes University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Timisoara</u>: Applications should be submitted by e-mail <u>relint@umft.ro</u> The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks. After having received the paper application, the letter of admission will be send within a max. period of six weeks.
- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the
 assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 7. Termination of the agreement: September 2021 or otherwise agreed upon by both partners.
