Please send your completed Registration Form to both of the following e-mails: daninamuntean@umft.ro, sturza.adrian@umft.ro and indicate your preference for oral or poster presentation on the registration form.

The registration fees will be **250 EUR/person for participants** and **150 EUR/person for PhD and master students, early career researchers** (ECR, researcher within five years after obtaining the PhD degree and not older than 35) **and mid-career researchers** (MCR, researcher within ten years after obtaining the PhD degree and not older than 40) – documentation required to be submitted together with the registration form. The registration fee covers the congress materials and attendance of the scientific program, welcome cocktail, gala dinner, sandwich lunches for 2 days and coffee breaks.

Participation of the undergraduate students to the scientific program is free of charge; the Certificate of Participation can be obtained based on the daily attendance to most of the sessions.

Registration fees should be paid by bank transfer and the payments details are found in the Registration Form. Please indicate your family name, city and IACS 2023 on the payment form for easier processing. Conference abstract submission deadline with early-bird fee: August 20th, 2023 for oral or poster presentation. Please indicate your preference for oral or poster presentation on the registration form.

Late registration and abstract submission is possible until the 15th of September at 300 EUR/person for participants and 200 EUR/person for PhD, master students, ECRs and MCRs, respectively.

On-site registration b(no abstract submission) is possible after September 20th, at 350 EUR/person for participants and 250 EUR/person for PhDs, ECRs and MCRs, respectively.

All participants will receive the Certificate of Attendance. Registration Fee invoices will be issued (upon request).

ABSTRACT PREPARATION

General requirements: Please use Word docx or doc format.

Please use Times New Roman font, font size 12.

Title: Please use bold and capital letters.

Author names: please list author names and underline the presenting author.

Affiliations: please include affiliations, designated by superscript numbers in case of several affiliations.

Abstract body: Maximum 300 words, with the following structure: Background & Aim, Materials & Methods, Results, Conclusion, followed by a maximum of 5 key words. In case you want to indicate funding, please do so in a separate line in *italics font* format at the end of the Abstract.

File name: please use the following format: family name of the first author.docx or doc (e.g. doe.docx). If one author submits several abstracts, the files must be numbered (e.g., doe1.docx, doe2.docx).
