



Prof. Ferenc Gallyas Jr., PhD, DSc
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After graduating as a chemist MSc in 1985, Dr Ferenc Gallyas Jr. worked for the Pharmacology Research Centre of Chemical Factory G. Richter Ltd. (Budapest, Hungary) as a researcher for 3 years before joining the University of Pecs Medical School (Pecs, Hungary), where he is a Full Professor and Head of the Department of Biochemistry and Medical Chemistry. He obtained his PhD in 1995 and DSc in 2008. He studies mechanisms of cell death with special interest in mitochondrial mechanisms and poly(ADP-ribose) polymerase-mediated cellular signaling. He has co-authored more than 100 scientific publications, which have received more than 3500 citations, his publication H-index is 32 and he has been an invited speaker at several prestigious conferences. Dr Gallyas is a member of seven Hungarian and three international scientific societies, Section Editor for PLoS One, editorial board member of Cancers and PeerJ and is a reviewer for major journals and scientific foundations.
