

Prof. Andrei Motoc, MD, PhD (Timișoara, Romania)

Prof. dr. med. Andrei Motoc has been the Vice-Rector for Postgraduate Studies and Residency, "Victor Babes" University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Timisoara since 2020. Before that he was the Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Medicine.

He is Professor of anatomy at the Department of Anatomy and Embryology of the "Victor Babes" University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Timisoara, being also the Vice-Chairman of the Romanian Anatomical Society and the representative of the Romanian anatomical society to the International Federation of Associations of Anatomists and the European Federation of Experimental Morphology.

His main research area focuses on the normal and pathological aspects of female reproductive system (uterus, ovaries, mammary glands), anatomo-clinical correlations in menopause and osteoporosis, modern 3D investigations and computer models, anthropometry.

He is a tenured physician specialised in Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the "Dr. Dumitru Popescu" Clinical Hospital Timişoara. Professor Andrei Motoc has been a PhD coordinator – with 13 finished and validated theses since 2008. He has participated in several national and international scientific events, both as organiser and as contributor. He has four patents recognised by the State Office for Inventions and Trademarks.
