Ioana Mozoș, MD, PhD, Dr Hab is Professor of Pathophysiology at the Department of Functional Sciences – Chair of Pathophysiology of “Victor Babes” University of Medicine and Pharmacy, from Timisoara, Romania and member of the Center for Translational Research and Systems Medicine/ She graduated with honors the Faculty of Medicine (1992), obtained her PhD in Medicine (2006) and defended her Habilitation thesis (2020). Prof. Ioana Mozoș has authored or co-authored more than 200 medical publications including original and review articles (180), editorials (2), book chapters (17) and books (5). Major and long-standing research interests of Prof Mozoș and her team have been related to electrocardiography, arterial stiffness, pulse wave analysis, vascular aging and cardiovascular risk. Prof. Mozoș organized and participated as invited speaker in numerous postgraduate courses, international summer schools, and scientific events. She actively participated as member of the organizing committees of several national and international meetings and served as reviewer for many international journals. She currently is a member of the editorial board of BMC Cardiovascular Disorders and evaluator for the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education. She is representative for Romania in the MC Committee of an ongoing COST action addressing vascular ageing.
