



Dr. Vesna Vučić, PhD
(Belgrade, Serbia)

Dr Vesna Vučić is a Principal Research Fellow and Head of Centre of Research Excellence in Nutrition and Metabolism, at the Institute for Medical Research, National Institute of Republic of Serbia, University of Belgrade. She received her PhD in Biochemistry and Physiology from the Faculty of Biology, University of Belgrade, where she lectured Clinical Lipidology in doctoral studies for 8 years. Her primary area of interest is the research of relationships between nutrition and health, with an emphasis on lipids and low-grade inflammation. Dr **Vučić** is dedicated to Evidence-based research, and is especially interested in precision nutrition which relies on nutrigenetics and microbiota, in diverse population groups. She was a PI or a co-investigator in several clinical trials investigating the effects of fatty acids and plant bioactives in inflammatory diseases, and supervised 5 doctoral dissertations. She was involved and led work packages and tasks in several national and EU-funded projects and published over 80 articles in ISI journals. According to Scopus, her number of citations is >1000 and Hirsch-index is 22. She is a mother of two children.
