My research activity has been carried out at several levels: within the department, as part of the team introducing and developing plastination technology for biological materials; within the faculty, as part of the group that developed an experimental model of uterine transplantation in animals; and in collaboration with colleagues from other institutions (Universitatea Politehnica, the “Fr. Rainer” Anthropological Research Center of the Romanian Academy, Bucharest).
