### Brief Description of Institution

Founded in 1944, "Victor Babeș" University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Timișoara is a public, research-oriented medical university and one of Romania's leading institutions dedicated to health sciences education, biomedical research, clinical training and professional development.

The University comprises four faculties: Medicine, Dental Medicine, Pharmacy and Medical Assistance, and offers bachelor's and master's programmes in Romanian and international languages of study, including English and French. Its doctoral education is organized in the fields of Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy.

The University has a substantial and growing student body, including a significant proportion of international degree-seeking students.

Its mission is to advance education, research and healthcare through high-quality medical training, scientific excellence, international collaboration and service to society, in Romania and the wider European academic area.

##### -D1.1.4 Of which was derived from donations and endowments

refers to funds received by the institution or institutional endowment from individuals, corporations, foundations, alumni organizations, or other external entities, with no restrictions or only limited restrictions on their use. This excludes revenues from investments of endowment funds.

#### -D1.1.5 Of which was derived from self-operating activities and investments

refers to the revenues generated by the institution through self-operating activities, service provision, investments (including investments of endowment funds), and the management or utilization of institutional assets.
